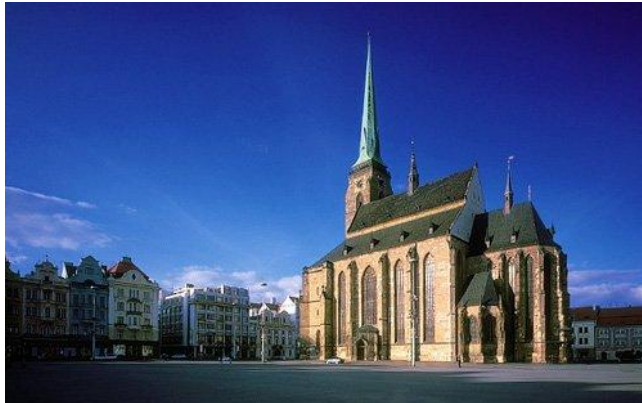




Plzeň

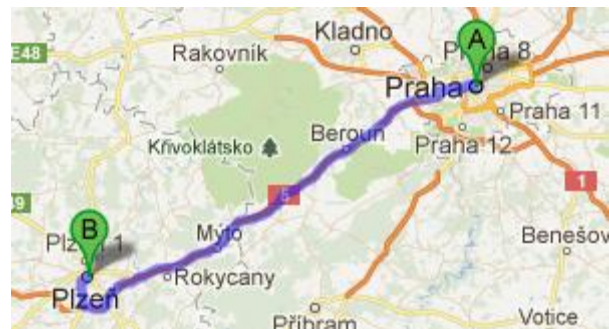
Discover a city where the most famous Czech beer Pilsner Urquell was born!



Plzeň is the fourth biggest city in the Czech Republic, located in West Bohemia about 90 km far from Prague. It is a very favorite destination of many tourists every year as you can find there the largest Czech brewery which made Czech beer so world famous.

In Plzeň we will do a short sightseeing tour of the center and then we will go to the brewery where you will see how beer is being produced there nowadays. We will also visit historic brewery cellars where you will get a unique opportunity to taste unfiltered and unpasteurized beer straight from big oak barrels. Our last stop will be in Brewery museum, where you can breathe the atmosphere of the Middle Ages and discover the secrets of beer production and the manner in which beer has been served and drunk since the far reaches of our past in an original house from the 15th century which enjoyed brewing rights and where the museum is housed today.
