



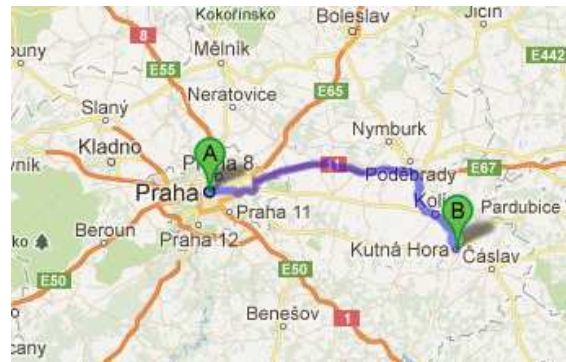
Kutná Hora
